TERMS & CONDITIONS

of the sales of casks



The sale transaction is for a cask of spirit filled by Uisge Beatha nan Eilean to be kept and matured in our bonded warehouse.

V.A.T. will be chargeable on the sales price of the spirit, and Duty (currently £22.20 per litre of pure alcohol; £7.15 per bottle at 46% alcohol), will be due to HM Revenue and Customs when the whisky is taken out of bond.

Ownership of the cask transfers when payment is received and cleared to Uisge Beatha nan Eilean's bank account. A stock certificate registering transfer of ownership will be sent to the purchaser.

Storage and insurance charges are included in the price for the first ten years. Any casks left in bond after ten years will be charged for storage and insurance at the then current rates.

The cask within which the spirit is stored is also the property of the cask owner.

All of our whiskies will be hand bottled and the cask owner is encouraged to bottle similarly. Should the cask owner wish to pay for alternative methods of bottling, for example off island, then the charges will be borne by the cask owner.

Uisge Beatha nan Eilean owns the rights to the trade mark Isle of Barra Whisky and all other variations of the term and use of any such link on the labels designed by cask owners must be approved by Uisge Beatha nan Eilean Ltd.

Uisge Beatha nan Eilean will undertake to buy back any cask.
